

ATELIER KITCHEN HAIDACHER

Once used by the Haidacher family carpentry as a workshop building, this small hut in South Tyrol was reinvented as a 21st century kitchen showroom. Under the gabled roof, architect Lukas Mayr created a single interior volume, burnished entirely in light-absorbing black resin. All focus is drawn to an enormous block in the middle, a kitchen island built in cherry wood with sterling silver elements and highlighted with pendant lamps. Mayr's design exercises restraint, whittling the concept of "kitchen" down to the idea of a gathering point rendered in warm, natural materials.
