Haidacher has been doing joinery work in South Tirol for 110 years. Until just a short while ago, the little workshop just stood there. Then Jochen Haidacher started thinking about converting the unassuming building into a studio for "Haidacher's Kitchen". The modest appearance of the hut is part of the idea. From the outside there are only vague hints that the building could house something special. Inside the gate another world opens up: what does a high-quality custom-made kitchen look like in the 21st century? How does one conceptualize a kitchen? What is the key to timeless design? All walls, including all building wall elements, the floor and the ceiling were rolled with black epoxy resin. These surroundings absorb the light while a huge kitchen occupies center stage.





Take another look: the studio is completely integrated in the surroundings. Visitors and potential customers drive to this location specifically. The black steel door shutters are only open when Jochen Haidacher is there.
